ATTENDANCE POLICY

Good attendance is essential for a quality learning experience. Since the work is highly concentrated in fewer days than a regular school year, faithful attendance is required for credit to be awarded. Students who miss more than four (4) hours per session of classroom instruction in a course will not be awarded credit for the course. It is essential that students and their families plan their summer activities before the student registers for summer **school**. Situations which take the student away from the class for more than four (4) instructional hours will prevent his/her earning credit. Punctuality is also expected. Three (3) tardy marks of no more than 5 minutes will be counted as an absence of one (1) hour. Tardies over 5 minutes will count as one (1) hour of missed class. Exceptional situations may be reviewed. Any time missed because of disciplinary infractions will be counted against the four (4) hour time limit.

DISCIPLINARY STATEMENT

All students will be expected to adhere to the student code of conduct. Violations of the code of conduct could result in the student missing part or all of the time remaining in the school day or complete dismissal from the class. Disciplinary time is deducted from the four (4) hour attendance limit. There will not be a refund of the registration fee if a student is dismissed from school for behavior or attendance problems.

Health & Wellness Room 104 ½ Credit

This course meets the state requirements for high school graduation. Unit topics include healthy lifestyle choices, body systems, diseases and disorders, reproductive health, and tobacco, alcohol & drugs. The body systems will be covered as they pertain to unit content. Optional units may include D.A.R.E. presentations and CPR training depending on the availability of instructors. **Prerequisite:** Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior Standing

Physical Education Auditorium ¼ Credit

This course offers bowling, volleyball, softball, badminton, tennis, golf, table tennis, aerobic/anaerobic activities, and swimming. Students must have a one-piece swimsuit. There will be an additional \$35 charge for fees that includes Copley Greens, a trip to a golf improvement center, bowling at Riviera, roller skating in Tallmadge, and biking on Towpath.
