1. Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update

Mr. Poe, Superintendent, reported that vaccines are anticipated to be given to employees on February 4, 2021. The second vaccine is anticipated to be given February 25, 2021. The vaccine will be given by Akron Children's Hospital personnel. Once the second date is confirmed, a calamity day may be scheduled for the day after. Only employees that signed up in advance will receive the vaccine.

Mr. Poe also reported that his intention for next school year (2021-2022) is still to have everybody wear face coverings while maintaining social distancing. Virtual learning will still be an option for families that prefer that method.

Discussion has been ongoing at the high school regarding the annual prom and graduation. Graduation activities such as a parade and procedures for picking up caps and gowns may be similar to those done in June 2020. The graduation ceremony will likely be held at the high school stadium in order to maintain social distancing. A prom dance will likely not be held. The post prom committee has been working on alternative ideas.

2. Permanent Improvement Projects (Summer 2021)
Mr. Wheadon, Treasurer, reported that busses and other vehicles will be ordered as needed. In addition, computers and textbooks will be ordered. A discussion occurred about restroom renovations as an additional project. At this time, the stadium renovations will continue to be on hold while the pandemic continues.
