B.. Topics

1. Review of the March 15, 2022 Agenda Items  
A review and discussion of the Tuesday, March 15, 2022 regular meeting agenda occurred.
2. Copley Township Sidewalk and Fuel Pumps  
Copley Township is applying for a grant from the Ohio Department of Transportation - Township Stimulus Program to construct a sidewalk along Ridgewood Road to Cleveland–Massillon Road and another along Cleveland-Massillon Road by the middle school. The township is requesting a letter of support from the board of education for the Ridgewood sidewalk since the project would extend along the high school property. The board of education indicated they would be willing to offer a letter of support.

The two fuel pumps at the bus garage are in need of replacement. Administration has received estimates of about \$50,000 to replace the pumps. Since the township uses the fuel pumps as well for their vehicles, they will be asked to pay a portion of the replacement cost.

3. Building Rentals/Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA) Tournaments  
There is a concern with the lack of personnel available to work during building rentals and OHSAA sponsored tournaments. If staff isn't available in the future, rentals will have to be denied and/or cancelled.

During the recent OHSAA basketball tournament, a visiting school district's administrator was verbally abusive towards the OHSAA site manager.

4. Voter Registration  
A question was raised prior to the meeting by a community group about voter registration of high school students. The high school government classes have
