- **NEW POLICY:** All students driving must purchase a Parking Pass. The cost is \$50 per year (or \$25 per semester), due when you are issued a parking pass.

Parking Lot Rules

Failure to follow could result in a Detention and/or loss of driving privileges.

1. At all times you must have a parking pass displayed. It should be hanging from your rearview mirror, facing forward and not blocked by anything, so attendants can read it. If you change cars, you must still display your pass, so be sure to take it with you.
2. State law is 10 MPH while driving on school property.
3. Treat the aisles the same as you would on a road! You **MUST STOP** at all main aisle ways before crossing. By not doing so, YOU may be the cause of an accident.
4. No students are permitted to park in the Staff Lot by the tennis courts, the Circle in front of the school, The Tomahawk Lot, the yellow angled lines in the student lot at the end of the aisles or any Handicapped Parking spots.
5. Students must park straight in "ONE" parking space in the student parking lot. You may not park in an aisle way anywhere in the lot.
6. Students leaving lot **MUST STOP** at attendant's shack and have a permanent pass or a pass from the main office to leave. If there are passengers in the car, all students must have a pass to leave.
7. Students are not permitted to their car during school hours without a pass from the main office or a teacher. Passes must be shown to parking lot attendant **BEFORE** going to your car.
8. Students are not permitted to play ball or throw frisbees in lot after school. This is too dangerous due to all the traffic.
9. When exiting after school there is no passing or cutting in front of other cars. Students must line up and wait his/her turn to leave.

***Driving on school property is a privilege that can be suspended!
