Blizzard Bag Assignments Day 2

Kindergarten/1st Grade

Use the three items you found in your kitchen for the last assignment. Find a song on the radio and play the steady beat along with the song. You may use your hands to play the steady beat. You may want to ask your parents if you can use a kitchen utensil like a spoon to play the steady beat.

How many songs did you play with your steady beat?

2nd Grade

Look in your kitchen for foods that have one and two syllables. (Example: cheese, apple)

Write an 8 beat pattern using the food words. (Example: cheese, cheese, apple, cheese, apple apple cheese cheese)



Write the pattern again using rhythm symbols.

One syllable = quarter note = ta

Two syllables = two eighth notes = ti ti

You may also use a quarter rest if you would like. Please end your pattern with a quarter note.



3rd/4th Grade

Practice playing your rhythm from the previous assignment. Do you like it? Do you need to make any changes? Add at least two rests to your 8 beat rhythm pattern. Write your revised rhythm pattern below.

Find an object in your home that makes a sound. (Example: a pot or pan, large plastic container, the trash can) Find an object in your home that could be used as a mallet. (Example: pencils, spoons, spatulas) Please use good judgment and ask permission before making your final instrument and mallet selection. Practice playing your 8 beat rhythm pattern using these found instruments. Write below what instrument and mallet choices you made.
