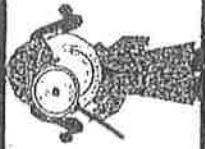

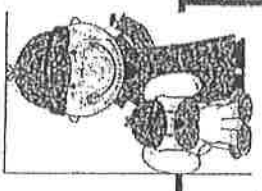
Math - Complete “Number Detective” worksheet (68).
