Listen To This!

Did you know that crickets have ears on their legs? Many animals have ears in strange places. A grasshopper has ears on its abdomen or belly. Some wasps have ears on their feet. Birds hear through small openings in their heads. Sometimes these small holes are covered with feathers. Sometimes they are not.

Animals use their ears in different ways. An elephant's large ears help keep it cool. A rabbit's ears can move. This helps the

rabbit hear in all directions. A dolphin uses its ears to find food. To do this, a dolphin sends out clicking sounds. When a clicking sound bounces off a fish, the dolphin hears an echo. By listening to the echoes, the dolphin can tell where the fish is. It can also tell the size and shape of the fish! Some bats use echoes to find insects.

Not all animals have ears. Snakes and worms do not. Some moths and butterflies do not. These animals use other senses to learn about the world around them.

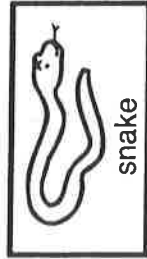
