FINAL REMINDERS

NAVLANCE - Update Schools

- ★ Log into Naviance
- ★ Click Colleges
- ★ Click Colleges I'm Applying To
- ★ Click Pencil (Edit), Next to each school, then click the drop down under Result
- ★ Update the result for each school (denied, accepted, waitlist, etc)
- ★ Click Save College Application
- ★ At the bottom of the Colleges I'm Applying to Click College I'm attending, then Update

TRANSCRIPTS

- ★ Final transcripts will have all your courses listed, final grades, final GPA and graduation date. Colleges, work programs and employers will want to see your official final transcript. To be official the Copley High School Guidance Office must send the transcript directly to the location. After you graduate if you ever need your final transcript sent you must contact the guidance office or email Mrs. Keith (kim.keith@copley-fairlawn.org)
- ★ Final Transcripts will go out Mid-June after all classes are updated grades are verified and GPA's are recalculated. Colleges start asking for Final Transcripts sooner but we are unable to send these Transcripts until everything is verified.
- ★ CCP - if you received college credit during high school, you must request final transcripts from the college or university you attended. Colleges will not accept credits from a final high school transcript.
- ★ CCP at The University of Akron - you can request a UA transcript through their MyAkron account online by selecting the "Request Transcripts" icon. Students should WAIT until final grades have been posted on May 12 before making any requests.

- ★ **Click the ONE box next to the school where you are sending your Final Transcript**
- ★ Click Done
