- Testing started 4-15-19 – we have several weeks going further
- Scheduling meetings: 5th & 6th – April 29th, 7th & 8th – May 1st – both @ 6pm
 - The goal is to have more academic time during the school day
 - Flex time/Intervention time to provide extra support for the students, if the kids don't need intervention there will a variety of extra activities/classes they can choose from
 - 5th grade recess will remain the same, 6th grade recess will be the same several days/week
 - Moving from 3 electives to 2
 - Band discussion – may have more kids who really “want” to be there which could create specialty type music programs
 - 10 min. longer academic classes for 5th and 6th & 5 minutes longer for 7th & 8th
 - Not just Ohio scores. We are not growing kids. Progressive report is showing us lacking as a school. Surrounding schools are excelling and we aren't. Research based strategies. If people aren't thriving, they can get the extra time for intervention & enrichment if they don't need that then they can – choose an elective.
